


Eureka Springs is a historic city in northwest Arkansas that sits in Ozark Mountain, in Carroll County, USA. Eureka is a Greek word which means "I have found it". It has the population of approximately 2500. The National Trust for Historic Preservation has named Eureka Springs as one of America's Dozen Distinctive Destinations.

This small town has a beautiful architectural design that will remind you of a typical European town. It is known as 'Little Switzerland'.

The city has attracted wealthy residents over the years because of its Victorian houses. Here is a list of all places you must visit when you go to Eureka Springs.

25 THINGS TO DO

1 | Downtown of Eureka Springs



Go to the spot where Spring Street meets Center Street

Spring Street is said to be one of the popular streets in Arkansas. It was named by the American Planning Association in 2010 as one of America's 10 Best Streets. It is the heart of Eureka Springs and boasts of restaurants, shops and hotels that are historic in design.

Art galleries and museums also contribute to the pool of attractions in the historic town. Basin Park Hotel contributes to the historic look of this area.

Festivals & Theaters

Eureka Springs is known for live music and magic shows. The Great Passion Play is very popular; it has been viewed, since it opened in 1968, by more than 7.7 million people. There is also a 3 Day Volkswagen festival which is popular amongst Volkswagen lovers.

At the annual Bluegrass Festival you will be treated to performances by very good musicians. Similarly, Eureka Springs into Music offers a Classical Music Festival.

You might also enjoy a show at Gaskin Switch Theater with Mark Wayne Beers; Intrigue Theater, Ozark Mountain Hoedown or see a Tribute to Willie Nelson at Outlaw Willie.




2 | The Rainbow Staircase

The rainbow staircase is known as 'Cash and Boardman Mural' put together by artists and volunteers through the Up Project in 2015. The staircase is located downtown, off Spring/ Center Streets, opposite Basin Park Hotel. You will have to go down the stairs and take pictures from the bottom in North Main Street.

3 | Blue Spring Heritage Center and Gardens


5 | Motorcycle Rides



Eureka Springs and its roads are smooth; as you maneuver through hills and forests you will be met with spectacular views and unforgettable experience.


8 | River lake Outdoor Center

You can also explore art at Art of Eureka Springs.




